

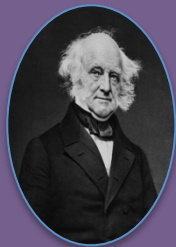

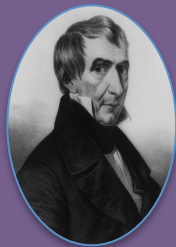

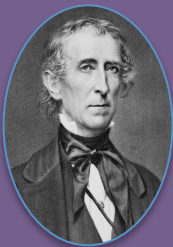
U.S President

Born on January 15, 1841. A British politician and creator of the National Hockey League Stanley Cup trophy.

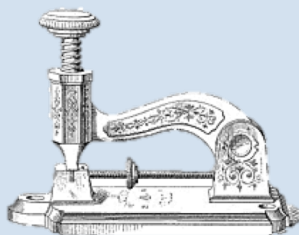

1 Great Invention

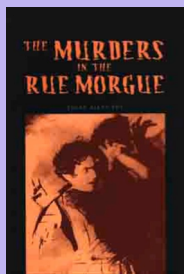


The Stapler
